ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT

- **Must be Hudson County Resident**
Jersey City residents please seek assistance with the City of Jersey City
- **Must have received a summons for eviction or notice to quit from landlord**
- **Household must have been financially impacted directly or indirectly by COVID19**
- **Household must meet income guideline below**

If you are unable to apply electronically, you may visit the Hudson County Dept. of Housing and Community Reintegration at 257 Cornelison Ave, in Jersey City to apply in person from 2/16/21 through 3/26/21 from 8:30am to 12:00pm. Bring the following documentation: Copy of Lease, Picture ID, documentation you are facing eviction, documentation of all sources of income. You can also apply via phone by appointment. Please call 201-209-2826 or 201-209-2827 to request a phone interview for CARES.
